As the Centre has been transformed into a public establishment, the Director selected will be expected to provide leadership and innovative solutions to ensure transparency, more efficient management of the research institute and to enable closer cooperation with the business and scientific communities. The research and development conducted by the Centre is of particular importance in addressing environmental, agricultural and health problems and challenges, and in preserving and sustainably using natural resources.

The Centre employs 309 people, 161 of whom are researchers. The Centre has 22 scientific laboratories and other operational support units.
